

Greater Seymour Trust Fund Awards \$20,542 in Grants

At a recent meeting of the Board of Managers of the Greater Seymour Trust Fund, the Board of Managers awarded special one time grants to the following recipients:

- ***The ARC of Jackson County*** received a \$1,100 grant to purchase furnishings for the Personal Enhancement Program and an electric range for Stonebelt of Jackson County.
- ***Big Brothers Big Sisters*** received a \$1,500 grant to purchase a new copy machine for their office.
- ***The Boys & Girls Club of Seymour*** will use their \$1,000 grant to purchase two Wii games for the Club.
- ***Child Care Network*** was awarded a grant \$1,110.76 to purchase tables and chairs for their Emerson Kids Klub site.
- ***Community Provisions of Jackson County, Inc.*** has been awarded a \$1,500 grant to purchase a laptop computer and projector.
- ***Girls Inc. of Jackson County*** was awarded a grant in the amount of \$8,850 for computers to support their Economic Literacy program.
- ***Healthy Families Jackson County*** was awarded a \$200 grant to purchase activity supplies for children.
- ***Human Services Inc.-Head Start Seymour Center*** was awarded \$2,781.24 to assist with the remodeling of the kitchen at the Seymour Head Start Center.
- ***Special Olympics Indiana Jackson County*** was awarded \$2,500 a grant to purchase new uniforms.

The Greater Seymour Trust Fund was established in 1969 by the late E. S. Welch to serve the cultural, scientific, religious, literary and educational needs of the community. The Trust receives funds from the public as gifts or bequests to be held by the trustee, Jackson County Bank.

A board of Managers of the Trust Fund meets annually to allocate the money from the Funds for a wide range of public purposes. Its purpose is to assist, encourage and promote the welfare of present and future residents of the community without regard to race, color or creed. Special one time grants are available from the Nellie Kloeker Fund, Evie Scott Fund, Miriam Newkirk Fund, and Verna Robertson Fund. The Board of Managers consists of the Mayor of Seymour, the President of the Seymour Jaycees, three at-large members and the President and Trust Officers of Jackson County Bank.

The fund has bank management and trust safeguards. Contributions to the trust qualify as charitable contributions which may result in income tax and estate tax savings.
