

## **Greater Seymour Trust Fund**

### **Awards \$20,309 in Grants**

At a recent meeting of the Greater Seymour Trust Fund Board of Managers special one time grants were awarded from the Evie Scott Fund, Verna Robertson Fund, Miriam Newkirk Fund and the Nellie Kloeker Fund to the following recipients:

- ***Anchor House*** was awarded \$3,385.00 for the purchase and installation of a new Fire and Security System
- ***Child Care Network*** was awarded \$1,000.00 to provide a weather alert radio to child care providers in Jackson County
- ***Community Agency Building*** received \$2,137.00 to purchase tables, chairs and a white board for the second floor conference room
- ***Community Provisions of Jackson County, Inc.*** has been awarded a \$1,000 to purchase and upgrade computers
- ***Healthy Families Jackson County*** was awarded \$775.00 to purchase car seats for new born infants;
- ***Jackson County American Red Cross*** was awarded \$1,500.00 to purchase new computers and software
- ***St. Ambrose Catholic School*** was awarded \$1,000.00 to purchase student accelerated reader books
- ***Jackson County Special Olympics*** was awarded \$582.00 to purchase sports equipment
- ***Girls Incorporated*** received \$3,000.00 toward the purchase of a new van
- ***LaPaz De Cristo Social Ministry*** received \$1,427.00 to purchase books and supplies for ESL classes
- ***Read Jackson County*** received \$1,503.00 to purchase books, television and DVD player
- ***Seymour Police Department*** received \$3,000.00 to purchase AED devices for patrol cars.

The Greater Seymour Trust Fund was established in 1969 by the late E. S. Welch to serve the cultural, scientific, religious, literary and educational needs of the community. The Trust receives funds from the public as gifts or bequests to be held by the trustee, Jackson County Bank.

A board of Managers of the Trust Fund allocates the money from the Funds for a wide range of public purposes. Its purpose is to assist, encourage and promote the welfare of present and future residents of the community without regard to race, color or creed. The Board of Managers consists of the Mayor of Seymour, the President of the Seymour Jaycees, three at-large members and the President and Trust Officers of Jackson County Bank.

The fund has bank management and trust safeguards. Contributions to the trust qualify as charitable contributions which may result in income tax and estate tax savings.
