**SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS**

**GENERAL CRITERIA FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:** Applications for these scholarships are evaluated, to varying degrees, based on: 1) Academic achievement, and 2) school and community involvement. - Financial need a consideration

MAKE A DIFFERENCE Career Scholarship

- Must reside in Seymour Community School District
- Financial need, circumstances of hardship a consideration
- This fund is primarily for working adults (non-high school students), but can provide scholarships for graduating seniors not pursuing a traditional college

track. **Non-degree seeking students** must pursue *vocational or career related certifications* through accredited educational or instructional programs.

- Two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members; prefer one from the field of education and one from the community-at-large. Letters of recommendation are to include information relative to moral character, motivation, goals, and financial need.

Robert D. "Bob" Pollard Memorial Scholarship

- Must be seeking diploma or certification in diesel engine repair or general auto mechanics; preference will be given to student working towards diesel engine technician certification
- Must reside in Jackson County
- Financial need and GPA are considerations

Amanda Stahl Scholarship

- Graduating student of Jackson County
- Must be pursuing a degree in Veterinary Science and/or Agriculture
- Three (3) letters of recommendation
- Consideration shall be given to GPA; FFA participation; 4-H membership; volunteerism; community service

James T. Thompson Scholarship

- Must attend either Hanover College or Purdue University
- Must reside in Seymour Community School District

Dallas Tyler Scholarship

- Must reside in Seymour Community School District
- Financial need a consideration
