The Bauer, Owen, and Klakamp scholarships are available to graduating seniors of Seymour High School and provides a four-year renewable scholarship for tuition plus a \$1,000 per year stipend which can be used for any school expense. Currently, each scholarship has an annual value of \$11,388, and will provide up to \$45,552 over four years.

Ms. Ulrey plans to attend Indiana University to major in Biology. She also plans to attend medical school and become an OB/GYN. Mr. Rodriguez-Salas plans to attend Indiana University and major in Law and Public Policy. He plans to come a lawyer or politician. The Spray fund provides reoccurring yearly scholarships of up to \$2,000 to first-in-their-generation graduating seniors of Seymour High School. A senior must also be a current resident of Jackson County and be the first person in their family whose biological parents, siblings, or grandparents did not complete a four-year college degree.
